LATEST NEW DIRECTIVES FROM THE GOVERNEMENT TO FIGHT THE THIRD WAVE AND VERY AGGRESSIVE COVID 19 PANDEMIC

The Chief Executive of Hong Kong SAR has issued after midnight a series of very stringent actions to be effective at midnight today.

This morning further instructions from the Home Affairs Department, the Secretary for Food and Health and information and from the Leisure and Cultural Services Department, imposed on us stringent restrictions forcing us to close most of our facilities except our dining outlets.

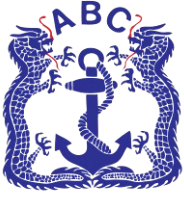
In order to comply with these new directives the General Committee has decided to implement the following new measures, on top of all the current requirements of masks wearing, temperature checking and others precautions in place since the beginning of the pandemic:

Please note that with effect at Midnight Tuesday 14th July 2020 until further notice, the following activities will stopped:

- All yacht, keelboat and dinghy racing
- Sailing courses and academy
- Dinghy, SUP and kayak hiring
- Swimming pool
- Children playground
- Game room
- Snooker room
- Squash
- Gymnasium
- Club Junk activity.
- All showers and changing facilities (toilets are still available)
- Waglan bar (except for food)

The following outlets and activities will be under restricted operation for a period of one week minimum (subject to further directives)

- Guest reduced to 2 maximum per account.
- Not more than 4 persons gathering in a group within the entire club.
- Not more than 4 persons per table.

- Food and Beverage outlets will operate normally until 6pm, at which time only the Galley Coffee Shop will remain open **for take away food only** with a last order at 8:30 pm and last pick-up at 9 pm.
- Middle Island will operate only on Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 11 am until 5 pm.

BOATING PRACTICE AND PONTOON USAGE

- Given the restriction to a maximum of 4 people in any one group, private boat owners with a crew or group comprising a greater number may use other means such as commercial sampans from public piers, to get to their boats or mooring.
- Sampan in the typhoon shelter will be suspended until further notice.
- VRC sampan service will be suspended.
- Ferry to Middle Island will be operating on demand for the purpose of visiting one's boat during the week and on 30 minutes schedule on Friday, Saturday and Sunday from 10:30 am to 5 pm.

Members are requested to understand that the Committee is acting to comply with Government Regulations, while keeping the Club operating for the benefit of the majority, it is in the interest of all members to adjust to the new reality in order that we may continue to enjoy the facilities that remain available.

Once again in order to preserve our staff and other members health, please wear your masks, wash your hands, use sanitiser and if you have a fever please avoid coming to the Club and seek medical advice.
