NOTICE TO MEMBERS

COVID 19 RELAXATION

Dear Members,

It is now confirmed that the swimming pool and the outdoor playground will re-open tomorrow.

Nevertheless, the baby pool and toddler's pool will remain closed.

As the leisure pools are to remain closed in Hong Kong, to be able to open our pool, only swimming in lanes will be possible.

Also, in order to comply with the condition set by the government, the following rules need to be conformed with:

- Opening hours 8am to 11:00 am then 11:30 to 10pm
- Maximum 30% capacity, that means for us 12 people in the pool at any one time.
- Maximum 75% capacity within the pool surrounds or 30 people.
- Please sign in and out the form at the entry.
- We recommend you to limit your usage of the pool to 90 minutes per accounts to allow everyone a chance to use the facility.
- I must reiterate that only swimming is allowed, no leisure activities such as playing, jumping etc.

As for the playground only the 20 people allowed inside at any one time, no eating or drinking allowed until the maximum capacity of 20 people is lifted, also as it is outside the licensed F&B premises it will be consider as breaching the ban on food and drinks consumed near a licensed premises as instated by the Food and Hygiene Bureau.

All that sound again very restrictive and for many surely a complete nonsense, but better that than being completely closed for Easter, as we have been for far too long.

All other restrictions in place, remain unchanged at least until 14 April:

- Our restaurants are opened until 10pm with four people per tables.
- **Gathering of people should not exceed four people.**
- We are still operating at 50% capacity in restaurant.
- Maximum people in a function room is 20 with separation
- All sporting and recreation facilities are opened with social distancing and mask wearing.

Please continue to declare your visit to the Club by using the Government apps "Leave Home Safe", or the registration book provided at the entrance.

Social distancing, wearing mask is still to be observed at any time and everywhere in the club while moving around, or just sitting in outlets, even on the pontoons. Please disinfect or wash your hands as often as possible.

All our staff continue to be tested for COVID 19 every 15 days as requested by the FHD.

We are now slowly returning to normal life, soon this COVID will be history let's keep our hope high and the infection low.
