As I previously informed you in my letter dated 30th April the Government has produced a quite complicated process for all catering premises, in order to have more people per tables and larger functions. In essence, the new rules create different modes of operation to allow some easing of restrictions.

We have carefully evaluated the new rules and in particular Type C Mode of Operations, which although would allow us to have 6 persons per table and service until midnight, would require us to designate and operate a separate zone with vaccinated staff, and to require all members to use the LeaveHomeSafe application on their mobile phones, and would thereby unfairly close zoned areas to a number of members who previously had free access.

We consider that it is impractical for the club to implement and operate a separate zone and so we will continue to operate as before, that is, under what is now called Type B Mode of Operation (listed below) until restrictions are eased more broadly by the HK government.

- Four per tables
- 50% capacity
- Declaration of visit through Leave Home Safe apps or written visit registration. Exemption
- Exemption for using the Leave Home Safe apps are for members over the age of 65 and below 15 who can register in writing.
- Temperature taking.
- Testing of our staff every 14 days
- 20 person per function still with social gathering separation.
- Party room such as our Junk limited to 4 people
- Gathering of people not exceeding 4.
- Proper air exchange.

In the meantime, I am pleased to report that at least 70% of our staff will be vaccinated, 20% still waiting and 10% have been exempted. We will continue to service you as safely and effectively as possible.
