Last week the Government announced the relaxation of COVID measures which I am sure you all heard about. We had to wait a little longer to announce what we will do as it was very unclear for quite some time if the sport of sailing could restart or not.

Nevertheless, we need to ask you once again assist us to comply with some general regulations, use the updated LHS App to enter the club and show your vaccination records or have your Exemption of vaccination paper ready for verification.

Now that we have received most information on sports resumption and consulted with our counter parts, we have a clearer idea what can or cannot be opened from tomorrow.

### DINING SERVICES RESUME AS FOLLOWS ON THURSDAY 21<sup>ST</sup> APRIL.

- The Galley will open now as usual with last order at 9:30pm and will close at 10:00pm.
- The Four Peaks will open for lunch and dinner and will close at 10:00pm with last order at 9:30pm.
- The Waglan Bar will open at 10:00am and will close at 10:00pm with a last call as 9:30.
- Middle Island will open Friday to Sunday at noon and will close at 9:30pm, last order at 8:45pm. (Last ferry at 9:30pm)
- Guest policy has now increased from 2 to 4 guests per account and that all over the club and Middle Island.
- We will now take bookings for the function rooms up to 20 people, respecting all social distancing and infection control measures such as vaccination pass, mask wearing etc.; you all know the drill.
- Tables will be set for 4 people and separated by 1.5 meters so please do not move them.

### RECREATION ACTIVITIES

**You must wear a mask while using our recreation facilities, unless of course you are drinking, eating or having a shower**

- Snooker re-opens with not more than 4 people at any one time.
- The Gym will open not more than 4 people at any one time.
