NOTICE TO MEMBERS

Friday 21st January 2022

MOVING TO TYPE D 3RD FEBRUARY 2022

As previously premised in my 6 January message, subject to the implementation details to be announced, the government has announced on the 24th February 2022 that everyone will need to produce proof of at least one dose of vaccine against COVID to be allowed access to most of the premises in Hong Kong

The Club access will, by default become a D type venue, opening up to more flexibility in table and function size but also to more checks restricting access to all non-vaccinated members and guests.

This means for ABC that only members and guests who have received their first dose of vaccine will be allowed to access any of the Club's facilities with the exception of those aged 12 and below with an accompanying adult, and those with medical certificate of vaccine exemption.

After long discussion and careful consideration the General Committee approved to start operating under **Type D from 3rd of February 2022.**

Please prepare your vaccine certificates either in your LHS apps or in hard copy so that we will be able to check vaccination record accordingly on arrival.

If you are exempted, your medical certificate will have to be produced for our record. Children under the age of 12 are so far exempted from mandatory vaccination.

GENERAL POINTS TO OBSERVE

- Masks must still be worn at all time except when drinking or eating.
- Temperature will still be checked on arrival.
- Maximum 6 persons per table. (Instead of 4)
- Dine-in services until 5:59 p.m. (No change so far)
- At least two-thirds of persons at the same table for non-banquets must have received the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine.(no more than one-third may be exempted).
- Maximum 240 participants in any one banquet. At least two-thirds of the total number of participants must have received the first dose of COVID-19 vaccine. (no more than one-third may be exempted).(large increase from type C)
- Must use the "Leave Home Safe" mobile application, except persons aged under 16 with an accompanying adult and members over 65 who can use the government registration form from the reception (no Change)
- The following four types of person may opt to complete the government record form, for access with no vaccination is it available online and at the reception in order to save time we strongly encourage you to complete the form in advance and hand it to the guard on arrival.

- Persons aged 65 or above
- Persons aged 12 or below;
- Persons with disability;
- Other persons recognized by the Government or organization(s).

- All staff members involved in the operation of the business on the premises must complete the COVID-19 vaccination course. *(All our staff are fully vaccinated 2 exempted and tested every 7 days)*
- Type D notice will be displayed on all floors and entrances. *(replacing the C ones)*
- Back to 100% of the seating capacity *(from 70% under type C)*
- We are required to use the "QR Code Verification Scanner" mobile application provided by the Government to scan your QR code of local COVID-19 vaccination record. Please have it ready on arrival to speed-up the process.

IMPLEMENTATION MEASURES FOR ABC

- We will have one ADDITIONAL check at the entrance using the Government Application to scan the vaccination QR code.
- The guards will be relocated at the outside door entrance of the club
- Another guard will be at the entrance of the car park for the same duty to ensure 100% check efficiency.
- Access to the pontoon is unchanged
- Middle Island has a permanent guard and will need to check the vaccination record as well as this venue is under a different jurisdiction.
- We are still disinfecting daily our tables, outlets and door knobs with vital oxide 852 disinfection spray, used by the Hospital Authority

Our staff have the full authority of the General Committee to decline entry to anyone who refuses or is unable to comply.

Sorry to sound like a prison warden; it really looks like this is what we have become in these COVID times. We apologies for any inconvenience caused but we will continue to strive for your utmost safety and your convenience.
