Dear Members,

RE: LATEST relaxed social distancing measure

On Tuesday our CE announced more relaxation of COVID measures. There will be an early set of relaxation from tomorrow and a second round will come on 19th May.

Regardless of the relaxation we still need to ask you once again to assist us to comply with the usual vaccine pass regulations, use the updated LHS App to enter the club and show your vaccination records (remember they must be up-dated to 30 April 2022 requirements)or have your Exemption of vaccination paper ready for verification. Please refer to my notice sent on 29th April for the vaccine pass updates.

DINING SERVICES RELAXED AS FOLLOW

- All outlets opening and closing remain as before, closing at 10pm. (On 19th of May this will increase to midnight)
- Guests' policy has now resumed as normal that is to say 4 guests per account all over the club and Middle Island policy will remain at 4 guests for the time being.
- We will now take bookings for the function rooms up to 20 people (increasing to 120 on the second round of relaxation. Of course we still have to respect all social distancing and infection control measures such as vaccination pass, mask wearing etc.; you all know the drill.
- Tables will be set for 8 people tomorrow and separated by 1.5 meters so please do not move them. On the next round this could be increased to 12.

RECREATION ACTIVITIES

You may now remove your mask while using our sports facilities during strenuous exercise

• Snooker, Gym, Indoor and outdoor Playgrounds are opened and follow the same pattern as before except that mask are not compulsory when doing strenuous

Now the big news:

- **The swimming pool is now finally re-openin**g. It is a very soft re-opening under the same conditions as in September 2020, below:
- We are only allowed a maximum of 20 persons inside the fenced area. You must sign up on the list for session of maximum 1hour and 30 minutes.
- Swimming is restricted to 3 lanes in which only 4 people can exercise and swim for a maximum of 30 minutes allowing everyone a chance to be in the pool.
- Masks are not compulsory while swimming and walking from the changing room to the pool but I am afraid when sunbathing it is this will give you a very distinctive smile.

SEAGOING SPORTING ACTIVITIESRELAXATION ON MASKS

No mask are required now when sailing being a strenuous activity.

ABC STILL CONTINUES WITH EXTRA PRECAUTIONS:

The club in house disinfection routine is done TWICE a day now including shower, tables, chairs and doors.

All staff members are tested everyday (instead of every 3 days)
