Job Responsibilities

Title: Dinghy Race Coach.

Mission:

To enthusiastically coach, teach and manage in a safe and professional manner a variety of dinghy coaching sailing requirements at our club.

Role:

The primary role of the Dinghy Race Coach is to assist the Head Dinghy Race Coach with the running of the ABC Racing Academy with support. A secondary role to assist from time to time with the running of club's dinghy races and regattas and to assist the clubs Marine Department as required when necessary.

Responsibilities:

Areas of responsibility will be as follows:

- Coaching the Racing Academy team, working closely with our Club Head Dinghy Race Coach.
- To develop short and long term plans for the Academy and sailors.
- To assist with the Planning and lead up for overseas trips for training/regattas for the Academy teams that have been approved by the Club.
- To occasionally assist with open days, taster sessions, school race training sessions etc if required.
- To promote racing within the Club sailors and outside the Club within the local schools.
- To work closely with the Club Head Dinghy Coach to improve club safe. practice, operating procedures and risk assessments.
- To work closely with the MI Dinghy Manager to maintain accurate student lists, records and monthly billing information.

Responsibilities Contd:

- To assist in improving club dinghy maintenance, working closely with club marine staff (You will only be expected to carry out repairs within your own ability and time constraints)
- To carry out administration and clerical duties in support of your role.
- To drive boats for courses if required and assist the Marine staff in launching and recovering dinghies and speed boats

Requirements

- Enthusiastic and motivated.
- Well presented with good verbal and written communication.
- Ability to work to a budget and a thorough understanding of operational costs.
- Experienced Sailing Dinghy Race Coach – RYA & HKSF Senior Instructor or other similar level qualifications: RYA, Yachting Australia will be beneficial.
- Dinghy Racing Coaching experience.
- Ability to work within a small team and flexible to work on weekends and Public Holidays.
- Computer skills: Microsoft Office.
- Methodical with good attention to detail, especially regarding current industry best practices.
